BYLAW NO. 1621

A Bylaw to Regulate Fireworks

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the City of Duncan enacts as follows:


1. For the Purpose of this Bylaw "FIREWORKS" shall mean high-hazard fireworks used for recreation, classified in Class 7, Division 2, Subdivision 2 of the Canada Explosives Act and Regulations, and includes Fire Crackers and Roman Candles.
2. No person shall sell or dispose of fireworks within the City of Duncan.
3. No person shall set off or discharge fireworks within the City of Duncan.
4. Notwithstanding the provisions of this Bylaw, fireworks may be sold to and discharged by a person or organization conducting a public display with the written permission of the Clerk of the Corporation of the City of Duncan.
5. Every person who offends against any of the provisions of this Bylaw, or who suffers or permits any act or thing to be done in contravention or violation of any of the provisions of this Bylaw, shall be guilty of an infraction of this Bylaw and shall be liable, on summary conviction, to a fine and penalty of not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$250.00.
6. Bylaw No. 852 of The Corporation of the City of Duncan is hereby repealed.
7. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Fireworks Bylaw, 1990.


