The City of Duncan invites applications from candidates with the proven skills, qualifications, and abilities for the position of Temporary Labourer (full time). The successful candidate will be required to perform a broad range of labouring duties in the routine maintenance and construction of all facets of the Public Works Department.

Required Skills, Qualifications, and Abilities:

1. Completion of Grade 12 or equivalent (G.E.D.)
2. Possession and maintenance of a valid Class 3 B.C. Driver's License with air endorsement; a satisfactory current driver's profile will be required.
3. Ability to perform physical labouring duties.
4. Ability to operate related maintenance tools and equipment.
5. Ability to communicate well with co workers and the public.
6. Ability to follow direction, use sound judgment and work in a safe, efficient manner.
7. Ability to adhere to safe work practices and procedures as outlined within City of Duncan Safety Manual.
8. The position will be physically demanding; the successful candidate may be required to undertake considerable lifting and digging. A certificate of fitness attesting to the suitability for the position may be required.

Preference will be given to candidates with experience in carpentry, construction, concrete finishing, road maintenance, utility system installation and ability to operate related machinery and equipment.

This is a CUPE Union position with an hourly rate of \$24.22 based on 37.5 hours per week.
